Legislative Watch

- HJR1008 - shorten the time to get a ballot initiative filed; increase how many counties from which signatures are required; eliminates the cure period after the Secretary of State's office has verified signatures

Celebrate Our Victories

- Rep. McCullough passed 3 bills addressing domestic violence.
- Rep. Hodges launched efforts to reduce certain sentence classifications related to drug possession.
- Rep. Richardson is taking a lead on eliminating fees associated with court fines.
- Rep. Collins passed a bill requiring new law enforcement to train to recognize an overdose and administer Narcan.
- Democrats came together to pass several bills to make solar power more accessible.
- Sen. Maloch passed a bill creating new vet tech certifications to help the agricultural field keep their livestock healthy.
- Rep. Ferguson has started work on a grant program directed toward rural economic development.
- Rep. Richardson passed a bill supporting Arkansas' portion of the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System.
- Democrats passed a bill ensuring expelled students still have access to educational opportunities.
- Democrats passed two bills to address dyslexia in public school.
